



## INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY



American Indian Development Associates, LLC (AIDA) is offering an internship opportunity to students majoring or minoring in social science programs.

The Tribal Victim Specialist Internship (TVSI) Program provides an opportunity for students to work in a tribal victim service program located in the Southwest. Students in the TVSI Program will have the opportunity to observe and assist tribal victim specialist or advocates provide services to victims of crime and learn how tribal victim services programs operate. Service provision may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Advising victims of their rights.
- Assist victims navigate the criminal justice system.
- Assist with data entry of case logs and case activities.
- Coordinate interviews between investigators and victims.
- Develop and conduct community outreach activities.
- Assist with writing reports.
- Provide information and referrals to community resources to victims.
- Inform victims of program services.

Internship details:

- Program length 8-10 weeks.
- AIDA will provide orientation and training prior to placement.
- AIDA will provide students participating in the program with a stipend.

Requirements:

- Students must be majoring or minoring in a social science program such as criminal justice, social work, psychology or sociology.
- Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 to be eligible.
- Students must be over the age of 18.
- Students must complete an application and an interview.
- Students must pass a background check.
- Students must have reliable transportation to travel to the tribal internship site during the entire internship period.
